**Please note:**

- CCArts occupies an old elementary school building. Artisan spaces in classrooms and on the stage (except the auditorium) are approximately 80 square feet, but may differ in shape; we ask that all artists bring flexible displays.
- You will be expected to **cooperate with your neighbors** during set-up and to **stay within your space**. For example, if you expect customers to be able to walk around the outside of your display, you must allow space for them to do so within your allotted space – not outside of it around the perimeter. Spaces may not have extra space around them, especially in the auditorium. Please plan your display accordingly.
